

## NOSC CHL Rules & Regulations

1. You must provide a positive, current photo ID before you will be accepted as a student. Acceptable IDs are your state driver's license, state ID card, or passport. Corporate or other organizational IDs are not acceptable. Expired IDs are not acceptable
2. NOSC requires payment in full in advance. Funds will be refunded in full if cancellation occurs no less than 72 hours before the start of the class for which you are scheduled.  
Tuition: \$100  
Discounts: NRA members, \$10  
NOSC members, \$20 (discounts are not additive, only the largest is given.)
3. Only people legally permitted to own handguns are permitted to take the NOSC CCW course. If your right to bear arms has been revoked, you may not take the course.  
Exception – Those under age 21 (but 18 or older) may take the course with the consent of a parent or legal guardian provided that said parent or legal guardian accompanies the minor. (Certification for an accompanying parent or guardian is only granted if they are accepted as a student, pay a second tuition, and pass all phases as described below.)
4. Privacy Policy: NOSC will never share, sell, nor divulge in any fashion information about class applicants or attendees. The only exception to this is mandatory compliance with a legal requirement or process in which records are subpoenaed.
5. Punctual, full attendance is mandatory. No certificate will be issued if any of the scheduled classes are missed unless cancelled by the instructor or NOSC, in which case any make-up sessions will be scheduled as soon as possible. Any sessions missed by a student will be made up at the instructor's convenience at extra cost. Tardiness will not be tolerated. If you are tardy, it is expected that you will consult with the instructor(s) at the first break to catch up with the class. Arriving after the first break is over is considered missing the session. Leaving early is not tolerated except in emergencies. An arrangement agreeable to the instructor must be made to cover any material so missed.
6. All test results and proficiencies are graded on a Pass/Fail basis. Failing any test or proficiency WILL DENY ISSUANCE of your CCW training certificate. Remedial sessions and/or other training will be offered to help students in this situation, any extra costs depending on the extent and other circumstances pertaining to the remedial action.
7. It is expected that ALL students will bring the following to every session:
  1. Pencil, pen, or other writing implement
  2. Course materials – these will be issued during the first session.
  3. Suitable handgun (subject to approval of the instructor) Please leave the hand cannons at home (.454 Casull, .500 S&W Mag., etc.) Those not owning one must make arrangements beforehand.  
→ Important Safety note.#1 All handguns will be brought to class in a box, case, or other suitable carrier in an UNLOADED condition. All magazines must also be UNLOADED. This will be verified at the door prior to entering every session.
  4. Holster for the above handgun (optional). Any holsters deemed inappropriate will be restricted in their use on the range per the safety note immediately below.  
→ Important Safety note #2. This class observes the "180" rule which stipulates that the muzzle of the gun may NOT point behind the shooting line. This means NO live fire will be initiated from any holster that allows the muzzle to point behind the shooter. Such holsters include but are not limited to these types: shoulder, small of back, cross-draw, certain ankle rigs, etc.
  5. 100 rounds of ammunition for the handgun. "Ball" or round-nose projectiles of any material are preferred. No magnum or hollow point ammunition will be permitted.
  6. Eye and ear protection. Shooting without eye and ear protection is prohibited. If you do not bring eye and/or ear protection, it will be provided at extra cost.
